" <i>snap in sunder</i> "	to separate something with force
" <i>asunder</i> "	into separate parts
" <i>galling chains</i> "	with the effect of frustrating and annoying somebody
" <i>vitriol</i> "	bitterness and hatred
" <i>poultice</i> "	a warm moist preparation placed on part of the body
" <i>gimlet holes</i> "	a small tool for boring holes in wood
" <i>depot</i> "	a railroad station
" <i>proceed</i> "	to continue
" <i>endeavored</i> "	made an effort to achieve something
